Students in our school achieved satisfactory results in 2017 HKDSE examinations. The overall pass rates, as well as the credit and distinction rates were higher than the average in Hong Kong. Over 70% of our students met the requirements for admission into the local 4-year degree programs (4 core subjects + 1 elective subject: 33222) and close to 100% of our students fulfilled the admission requirements for higher education programs (Chi + Eng + 3 elective subjects: 22222). The average pass rate of all subjects was close to 100%. The distinction and credit rate (Level 5 or above) of 9 subjects was higher than the average in Hong Kong and the distinction and credit rate (Level 4 or above) of 12 subjects was higher than the average in Hong Kong. Around 60% of our students were offered admission into degree programmes in local universities, Mainland China, Taiwan and overseas.

Our students have achieved excellence in external competitions in the current school year. For example, a Chemistry student took part in the 2017 Big Science Competition organized by the Australian Science Innovation and won the High Distinction Award, the highest personal award for Hong Kong. The Liberal Studies students won the Territory-wide Second Runner-up Award from an inter-school debate competition organized by the Centum Charitas Foundation and Hong Kong United Foundation. Our Science students won 1 Medal, 4 High Distinction Awards, 8 Distinction Awards and more than 20 Credits at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University Secondary School Mathematics and Science Competition. At the 2017 Science Assessment Test organized by the Hong Kong Association for Science and Mathematics Education, our students won 8 Gold Awards, 12 Silver Awards and 11 Bronze Awards. In July, two students were shortlisted for participation in the MIT Innovation Academy 2017 organized by the MIT Hong Kong Innovation Node, and the team in which our student competed received the Best Product Design Award. Our Visual Arts students received a Certification of Merit and an Award for Excellence at the Fire Safety Design and Chinese Drawing Colouring Competition and the 2017 Hong Kong Flower Drawing Competition, respectively. These achievements reflect the school's rationale of providing diverse and progressive education emphasizing whole person development. The achievements also demonstrate that when given appropriate challenges and opportunities, students have the ability to achieve personal breakthroughs and benefit from the diverse and remarkable results of learning.
