Results of HKDSE (2018)

Students in our school achieved satisfactory results in 2018 HKDSE examinations. The overall pass rates, as well as the credit and distinction rates were far higher than the average in Hong Kong. Over 80% of our students met the requirements for admission into the local 4-year degree programs (4 core subjects + 1 elective subject: 33222) and close to 100% of our students fulfilled the admission requirements for higher education programs (Chi + Eng + 3X: 22222). The percentage of students scoring 19 points or above in the best 5 subjects (including 4 core subjects 3322) was over 55.0%. The average pass rate of all subjects was close to 100%. The distinction and credit rate (Level 5 or above) of 11 subjects was higher than the average in Hong Kong and the distinction and credit rate (Level 4 or above) of 14 subjects was higher than the average in Hong Kong.
