### Seminar for Parents on Senior Secondary Subject Selection

The school has been providing senior secondary students with a coherent and diversified curriculum since the launch of the New Senior Secondary Curriculum in 2009. In response to the Education Bureau's recommendations in the New Senior Secondary Curriculum review report released in 2015, measures announced in 2021 for an overall optimization to the 4 core senior secondary subjects and the latest university enrollment requirements, S4 students are required to take 3 elective subjects and/or M2 (Mathematics Extended Part Module 2) in addition to Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics and Citizenship and Social Development.

The school will host a talk in the school hall at 9:30 - 11:30 am on 19 March (Sunday) to help S3 students and their parents understand the senior secondary curriculum design and elective subjects. Multiple pathways to tertiary education, strategies for senior secondary subject selection and the latest arrangements on senior secondary subject selection will also be covered. **Attendance is compulsory** for S3 students and their parents.
