

Performance in HKDSE and JUPAS (2025)

YOTTKP students achieved satisfactory results in the 2025 HKDSE examinations. The overall passing rates, as well as the distinction and credit rates, were far higher than the averages in Hong Kong.

92.2 % of the students met the requirements for admission into the local 4-year degree programmes (4 core subjects + 1 elective subject: 332A2) and 100 % of our students fulfilled the admission requirements for higher education programmes (Attained in ‘Citizenship and Social Development (CS)’ and 5 best subjects including Chinese and English: 22222).

The percentages of students getting ‘Level 3 or above’ (pass) in Chinese Language and English Language are as follows:

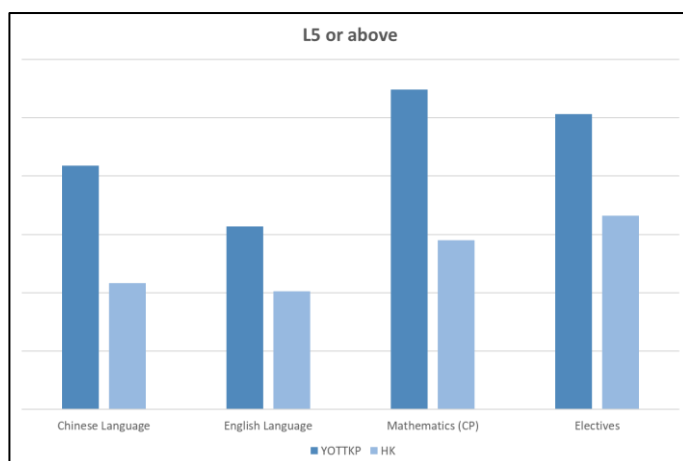
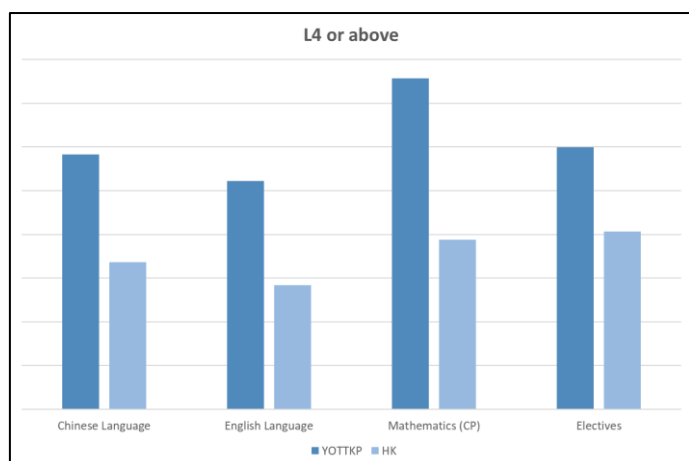
- ❖ Chinese Language: 96.5 %
- ❖ English Language: 94.8 %

There are more than 180 attainments of Level 5 or above in all the subjects taken.

Over 90 % of students were offered local Bachelor’s degree programmes in the 2025 JUPAS Main Round Offer Exercise 2025.

- (1) The percentages of students getting ‘Level 5 or above’ (distinction) and ‘Level 4 or above’ (credit) in Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics (Compulsory Part) and Elective subjects were far higher than the respective averages in Hong Kong.

YOTTKP students outperformed their Hong Kong counterparts in 15 subjects at the ‘Level 5 or above (distinction)’ tier, 12 subjects at the ‘Level 5* or above’ tier and 7 subjects at the ‘Level 5**’ tier.
